Last Chance to Start a Payment Plan for Property Taxes Delinquent for Five or More Years

Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector Shari L. Freidenrich, CPA, has published in the newspaper and online at oceny.com/defaultedproperties, the listing of all properties by city that have delinquent taxes outstanding for five or more years. All property that has been tax defaulted for five or more years may be subject to tax auction by the Treasurer-Tax Collector unless they are currently on a Five-Year Installment Plan. June 30, 2014 is the last day for an owner of real property to start a Five-Year Installment Plan for these properties. The property owner must qualify to enter into an Installment Plan by meeting certain criteria. If these tax-defaulted properties over five years do not have an installment plan started and in good standing by June 30, the only way to avoid the tax auction is to pay 100% of the taxes, penalties, and fees levied on the property prior to the date of the next tax auction. No partial payments or installment payments will be accepted prior to the auction date.

Have you moved or your business relocated and you haven't received a property tax bill recently? If so, and you did not file a change of address with the Office of the Assessor and not gone online to pay your property tax bill, your taxes may be delinquent. You can download a change of address form at occov.com/octaxbill, just click on How to and then on Request a Change of Address. An easy way to check to see if your property taxes are outstanding is to go online to occov.com/octaxbill and input either the property address or the parcel # (APN), click find, and then click on the APN link that will then identify if there are any outstanding property taxes. In future, taxpayers should consider checking this right before the tax installment last payment date to make sure that their payments have been processed. Another easy way to remember to make the secured tax installment payments, is to sign up for our email reminder system that sends an email when property tax bills are mailed, 10 days prior to the last payment date and one day prior to the last payment date.
